The deadline for submission is December 2, 2022, by 5:00 p.m. (CST). You will be notified on or by January 13, 2023, if your proposal has been selected.

If your proposal is selected, the following discounts will be applied to your registration:

Lead Presenter: \$100 discount off the registration fee for one (1) person designated as the lead presenter.

Co-Presenter: \$25 discount off the registration fee for co-presenters.
